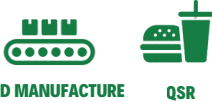

DIRECTIONS:
Open lid, remove entire cover, remove and discard seal. From centre of wipes roll up a corner of the wipe, twist it and thread through the hole in the container cover. Pull through about 1 inch (2.5cm). Replace cover tightly. Pull out first wipe and tear off at a 45 degree angle.

WHEN NOT IN USE:
Keep the tip of the exposed wipe inside the well in the cover, and the lid snapped closed.
